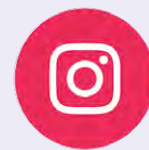

Full membership fee: £70

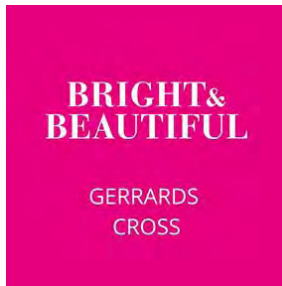
Military membership fee: £35
